For the new construction barn using electric hog farrowing heated mats or replacement of heat lamps with heated mats with automated climate controls in an existing barn. Using heat mats significantly reduceds heat lost to ambient air by providing direct heat transfer to the piglets. Replacement of heat mat to heat map does not qualify for this rebate.
