Schultz has volunteered for many things over the years, including the St. Joseph Lions and the ISD 742 Strategic Planning Committee.

If elected, Schultz believes the long-term goals of the Cooperative should be providing affordable and reliable energy, investing in new technologies such as renewable energy and storage options, and maintaining long-term financial stability. Other focuses for the Board could include succession planning for the utility workforce and tracking the accelerated push toward renewable energy and its impact on power grid infrastructure.
